The assassin, trying not to draw attention to himself, realizes he either has to calm him down or kill him. This though, is not that simple. The [est glues himself to the killer and doesn't let go, he comes in, goes out, runs around, yells, argues, begs, licks, harasses, irritates – the assassin is unable to get rid of him. He attacks in waves of nagging and bad luck, and whoever tries to initiate any contact with him is either injured, loses consciousness or their mind.
