Julia, a young Ukrainian, is sent by the Israeli Defense Ministry to take care of an IDF casualty who lives in a village near the border of the West Bank. Entering the neighbouring house accidentally, where a famous author lives with his musician son, she wins his confidence with her vivacious personality, and discovers he suffers from writer's block. Offering her help as a 'literature spy' she suggests to report back to him all the happenings of the neighbours, who are fighting both with him and among themselves, and consequently help him regain his writing ability.
